

## Millions of Cats

### QUESTIONS:

- Why did the man have such a hard time deciding which cat to bring home? Do you think this was a good way to choose? Why or Why Not? How would you have decided which cat to bring home?
- How did the cats choose amongst themselves who would stay with the man and the woman?
- How do you think the man and woman felt as they watched the cats quarreling?
- Why did the cats leave the one cat that was left alone? How do you think the one cat felt about being the only one left? What did the man and woman do to make the one cat, and themselves, happy?
- Imagine you had thousands or millions of pets. Where would you keep them? How would you care for them all? How would your original pets feel about having so many other animals around them?
- How do you think the cat felt about herself before the man decided to keep her?
- How do you think the cat felt about herself after the man and woman cared for her?
- (Exploring the theme of self-esteem): Share one or two things about yourself, i.e. what you like or dislike. How do you feel when you help your friends know more about you? What is the most important thing for your friends to know about you? How does it make you feel to know more about your friends? Why?
